3	Matters Arising

He is still waiting to hear from three clubs and confirmed that the deadline has been extended to Friday 28 th February in order to get back to him so that fixtures can be announced mid-March.

4	Fraser Reynolds, National Development Manager, Cricket Scotland	
	Fraser joined the meeting to talk about the new role of Cricket Development Officer – North which is being advertised. A job description for the same post in the Borders was circulated prior to the meeting. Once the person is in post, ideally before the season starts, their priority will be to meet with clubs and to offer support, engage with schools and local authorities. It should be noted that this role will not cover Moray as they already have supports in place. The post will initially be part-time, although the intention is to make it full-time and permanent as long as funding is in place.	
5	Player Registration	
	Fraser and Mike mentioned the importance of registering with the Cricket Scotland Registration Scheme and encouraged everyone to do this before the start of the season.
